

Exporting EPS from Acrobat 7.0

Use these settings to create EPS files from Acrobat 7.0 for placement in page layout programs such as QuarkXPress and Adobe InDesign.

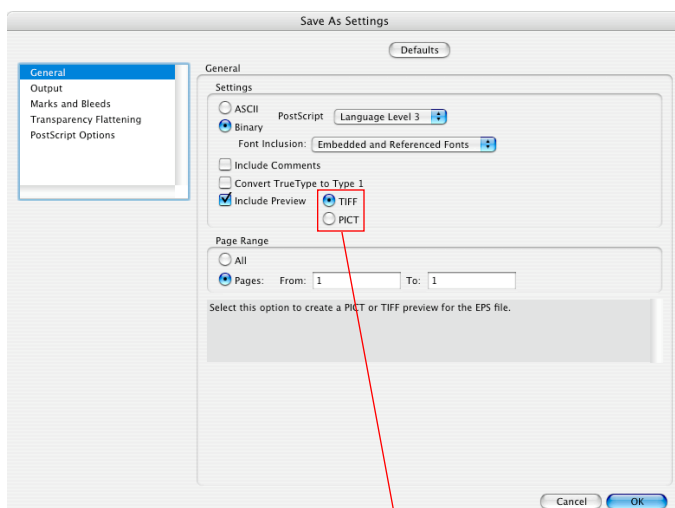
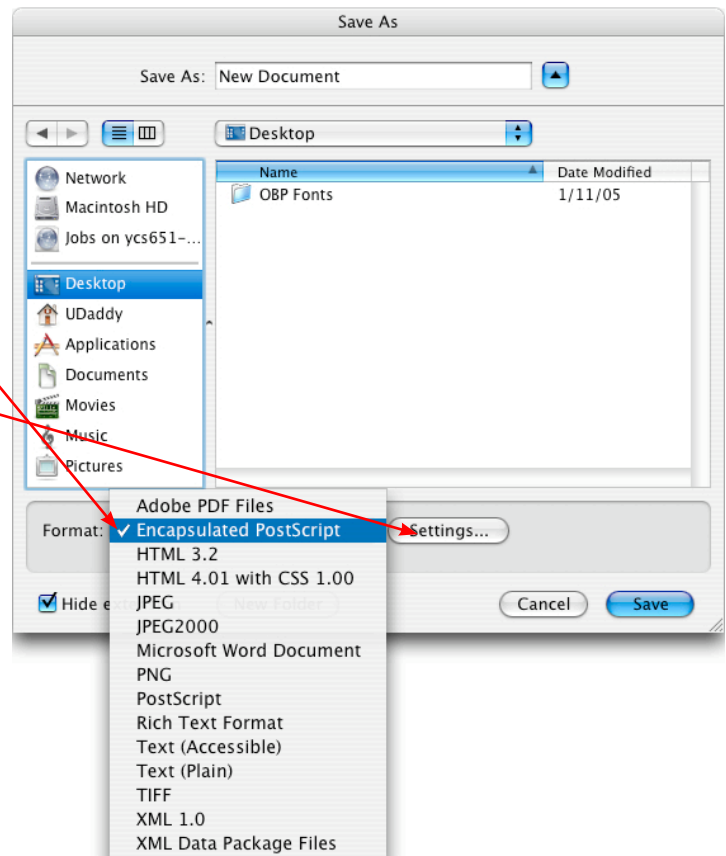
STEP 1—Open the PDF in Acrobat 7.0. Choose “Save As” from the “File” menu.

STEP 2—Choose “Encapsulated PostScript” from the “Format” sub-menu.

STEP 3—Click on the “Settings” button.

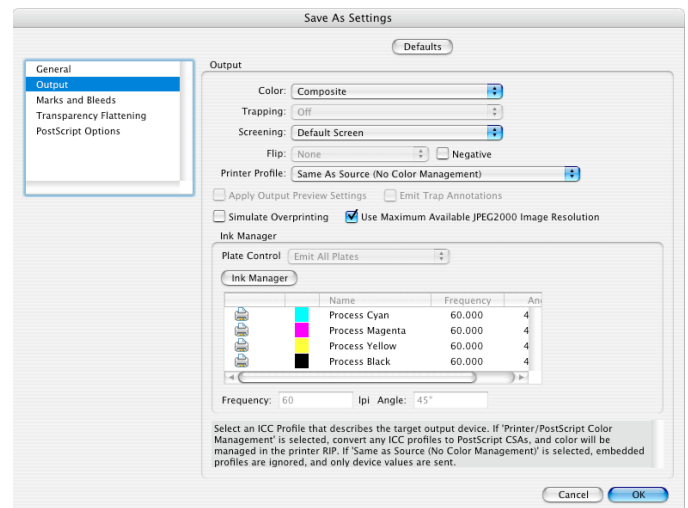
STEP 4—Use the settings on the following screenshots to save your EPS file.

NOTE: Screenshots are from MacOSX but will look and feel the same on Windows.

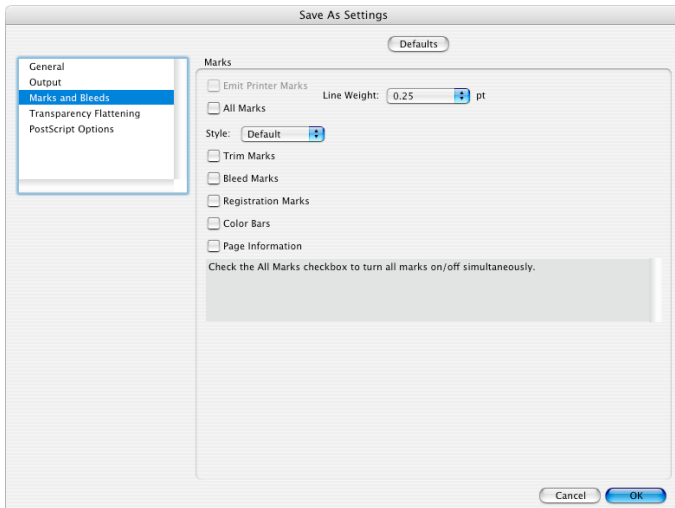

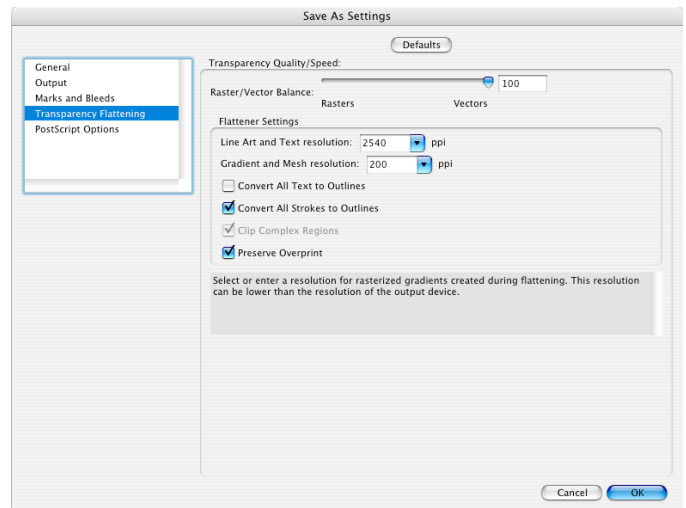
NOTE: The format option for the preview does not appear in the Windows version. Choose TIFF for OS X. Choose PICT for OS 9 use only.



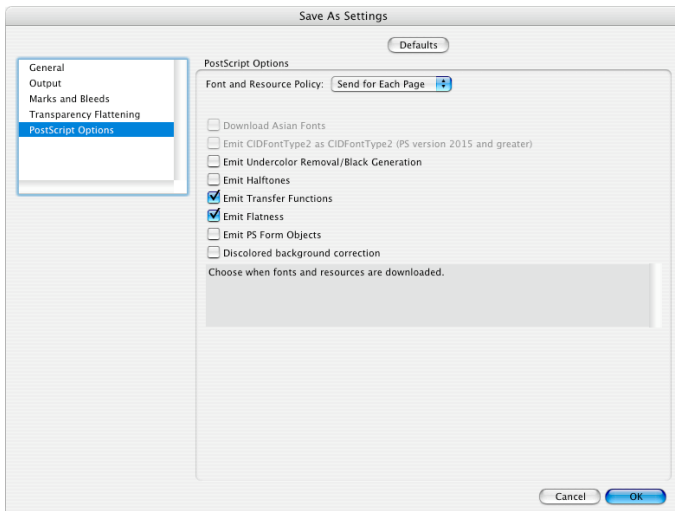
